### **St. Sebastian Parish Buddies Experiment**

AKRON, Ohio –

Kindergarten and eighth-grade students at St. Sebastian Parish School spent an afternoon working out tension in the school's science lab.

The kindergarten students enjoyed working with their eighth-grade buddies experimenting with elements of tension. Kindergarteners counted the number of drops of water they could place on a penny and a Japanese yen before the water over-flowed. They then made tie-dyed milk with food coloring and soap. Teachers, Mrs. Indriolo and Mrs. Schmidlin had a fish race in the water trough in the lab. Paper fish were put in motion when the surface tension of the water in the trough was broken by adding soap.

Student Madison Najeway especially liked "putting the raindrops on coins" while all of the students loved the "tie-dyed" milk experiment. The kindergarteners meet with the eighth graders several times during the school year for fun learning activities.
