Beloved Church Building





55-year-old pews, floors, and ceiling in need of repair, refurbishment

Our beautiful church was dedicated in 1960. For about 30 years before that, St. Sebastian parishioners worshiped and students learned in a combined church/school building. When the new church was built, the old church became the school lunchroom and social hall, now known as Zwisler Hall. So, while the parish is celebrating its 85th anniversary, our church is also marking its 55th anniversary as a place of worship.

The St. Sebastian Church is an amazing and aweinspiring structure, both impressive in its grand scale and delightful in small details. Have you ever paused to think of how many hands have clutched the sides of the pews as someone genuflected? Or how many feet have walked down the aisles for communion or during a wedding procession? Or how many knees have rested on the kneelers? Or how many children have squirmed in the pews?

For 55 years, this wonderful structure has been the site of many experiences of spiritual engagement and renewal, and many of us hold very fond memories of events that took place in our church.

However, if we set aside nostalgia and look closely at our church, with the eyes of the caretaker, we need to acknowledge that all this loving use of the building has also lead to wear and tear.

Our Beloved Church Building

While the church could be said to have "good bones," a major concern is the state of the woodwork, especially the pews. The church has about 120 pews and 360 kneelers, all of which are in serious disrepair. The finish of the pews is worn, scratched, and unsightly, and a kneeler or two falls off every week. The pews take up so much space in the church that their disrepair detracts from the overall beauty of the building.

The only way to properly restore them to their original working order and luster is to remove them so they can be sent out to be repaired, sanded and varnished, and then have book racks installed.

The removal of the pews would provide an opportunity to complete two other big projects: the refurbishment of the terrazzo floor and the repair of the ceiling. The terrazzo floor, which was painstakingly installed by skilled craftsmen, is worn and pitted and largely void of its original luster. Several areas of the ceiling have water damage, which is unsightly and a problem that cannot be ignored. All of these projects are large and costly, but absolutely necessary. Our church is a great source of strength to both the parishioners and the surrounding community. It's time to restore and repair so that the building can remain a foundation of faith and community for many more years to come.
