

# From our Pastor

Greetings, It is a blessing to be the pastor of this parish as we approach the


momentous event of our 90th anniversary as a parish. And more fortunate still are we all by the presence of the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation that allows us to function and dream in a way that most parishes cannot.

Our Foundation did not exist in 1933, when the bank that held the parish's savings went under, taking all of the funds the parish had saved up for its upcoming mortgage balloon payment. Monsignor Zwisler pleaded with the people of the parish to pledge funds over and above what they normally gave in order that parish might not default on its loan. And the parish came through! But what was left over after the mortgage payment was paid? Nothing. Well, we got to keep the building, but the bank balance returned to near zero.

That is similar to what happens with the funds that are provided through the weekly collection basket, tuition, and the church's other regular sources of income. The money that comes in goes right back out again for what is needed to carry on our mission of worshipping, educating, and providing the other various ministries this vibrant parish is blessed to be able to offer. We are fortunate that the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation was established in 1971 to generate and maintain financial resources for the church, providing not only long-term financial stability and crucial ongoing support for the parish and school, but also a source of funding for any unexpected expenses.

Recently, you were asked to help raise a phenomenal amount of money -one million dollars! - to restore our beautiful church in time for our 90th anniversary. I cannot tell you how grateful I am to you and to everybody who contributed to the campaign. However, once the work is done, and we are able to enjoy the beautiful and much-needed elements of the restoration, that one million dollars, like the funds in the example above, will have been put to good use and will no longer be available. It will be gone.

But this is not the case with the donations you make to the Unrestricted Fund of the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation. The Foundation's Unrestricted Fund is there to generate and maintain resources for the future of the parish. Donations made to the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation are carefully managed and invested so that support of the parish can be provided in all sorts of ways: helping pay church and school salaries, keeping tuition lower, and paying for repairs



to our buildings and grounds, as well as providing funds for other projects and services so that we as a parish need not constantly worry about money. In so many ways, the Foundation is there to support our parish and to lessen the strain on the collection basket.



It is wonderful to be a part of this community and to witness firsthand the generosity and support given to the Foundation. We are so very blessed to have such an incredible parish family supporting this legacy of giving and allowing the heritage and traditions of St. Sebastian to continue for many years to come.

The past year has been amazing. Thank you for your continued support of the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation. In more ways than one, the words "thank you" do not totally convey my appreciation for your support, but I hope this letter expresses my heartfelt appreciation for your kindness and generosity.

Since 1971, the sole purpose of the Foundation's existence has been to support our parish church and school. Fr. Byrider and the initial Foundation Board of Trustees certainly understood the importance of planning and preparedness. Their foresight and commitment ensured funds would continue to be available to support our St. Sebastian tradition. We are the fortunate beneficiaries of their thoughtful and meticulous design. In keeping with their plan, we are pleased to announce that once again, the Foundation's funds and endowments have grown in both asset value and number. Just this year, we have finalized two new funds/endowments that you will see featured in this report. I hope you will enjoy reading their stories!

Donations to the Foundation come in all shapes, sizes and designations. As you can see in the list of gifts on pages 8-11, many donations are "restricted gifts," or gifts designated for one of the Foundation's 70 named endowments, scholarships and funds. We are thankful for the important support these restricted gifts provide to a wide range of causes in the parish. The Foundation also receives "unrestricted gifts," donations that we consider to have a "mission critical" importance. Donations to the Unrestricted Fund (listed on page 11) help to support and maintain our church and school in ways that are not as publically heralded or visible but are certainly crucial. This includes things like repairs to the boilers, roofs, and HVAC

systems. The Foundation is especially grateful to receive unrestricted gifts since they provide essential funds to cover expenses in the areas of greatest need.



My appreciation of our parish community, parishioners, alumni, school families and friends would not be complete if I failed to mention The Cornerstone of Our Faith, our church restoration project. How amazing that we publically announced this project in May 2017 with \$300,000 in donations, and by the printing of this report less than 12 months later, we are moments away from reaching our \$1 million goal! Thank you for your support of our capital campaign!

Upth It has been truly amazing to see parishioners of all ages – from our school children to our oldest parishioners participate in raising funds for the restoration project. The school children collected coins to pay for upgrades to the church's lighting system, our young parishioners planned and enjoyed a taco fiesta, and on-line giving increased rapidly with our participation in the #weGiveCatholic effort – all in support of our project. Over 350 individuals and organizations have sent in donations ranging from 10 cents all the way to \$100,000. Wow! The generosity and spirit of our parish community is awe-inspiring. The restoration work will be well underway by the time you receive this report, with work scheduled to be completed by July, a few months before the parish's 90th Anniversary Celebration Gala on November 10, 2018. We hope you will join us!

The Lynn Frey-Steward Organ Scholarship Fund is a new scholarship fund at the Foundation that was created in 2017 in honor and recognition of Lynn Frey-Steward's 50th anniversary of being an organist. Since 2005, Lynn has been the organist at St. Sebastian Parish, where she is also director of music and choirmaster. The scholarship is dedicated to providing funds for organ lessons for young students interested in studying the wonder and beauty of playing the organ.

Lynn began playing the organ at age 8 and had her first job as a church organist at age 10. "The ability to play the organ is truly a gift from God," says Lynn, "and I am fortunate and blessed to have the ability to serve my church in this manner. Being an organist at St. Sebastian Parish Church has been an amazing and joyful experience for me. Giving back and being a servant to my faith is one of the greatest joys of my life."

Lynn hopes that this scholarship will encourage our grade school children (parishioners and/or current students in our day school) to consider taking organ lessons that will prepare them for service to the Catholic Church in the future.

The first Lynn Frey-Steward Organ Scholarship will be awarded in the spring of 2019, with funding to be applied to the 2019-20 school year. This scholarship, which is not limited to students with financial need, will be determined based on completion of the scholarship application by the January, 2019 deadline and submission of a letter of recommendation from a piano or organ teacher.

ST. SEBASTIAN CHURCH RESTORATION

#### A \$1 Million Restoration Campaign Launched in May, 2017

St. Sebastian Church is a beautiful and awe-inspiring place that serves as a cornerstone of faith for our parishioners and as an anchor of the West Akron community. In May of 2017, the St. Sebastian Parish Foundation, at the request of Fr. Valencheck, launched The Cornerstone of Our Faith, a \$1 million capital campaign to restore our beloved church to its full grandeur and beauty in time for the celebration of our parish's 90th anniversary in 2018.

#### More Than \$900,000 Raised By End of 2017

At the time of our May, 2017 launch, donations to The Cornerstone of Our Faith totaled \$300,000, and by the end of 2017, donations totaled over \$900,000! Thank you to everyone who has contributed to this success! In addition to monetary gifts, so many of you have helped the campaign through participation in the church survey (results were reported in January), the Town Hall Meeting in May, the Tacos & Trivia event in November, the #weGiveCatholic effort in November, and The Light of Our Faith school fundraiser in December. Additional events are planned for the 2018 calendar year, culminating with the 90th Anniversary Gala celebration on November 10, 2018.

#### **Primary Projects and Estimated Costs**



#### PEWS (\$200,000)

Completely refurbish the pews by refinishing the woodwork, restoring the kneelers, and adding book racks



#### DOORS (\$60,000)

Replace all interior and exterior metal doors and thresholds (glass and metal) and paint the door jambs



#### FLOORS (\$75,000)

Recondition the terrazzo and marble floors, which were painstakingly installed by skilled craftsmen, including the repair of wear & tear and restoration of the floor to its original luster



#### SOUND SYSTEM (\$25.000)

General maintenance and improvements (not a replacement)




#### SOUND BANK AND SOUND LOOP (\$30,000)

Replace the sound bank and add a sound loop



#### WOODWORK & BRASS (\$25,000)

Refinish woodwork (such as doors, cabinets, confessionals), re-plate brass in sanctuary





#### MAIN ENTRANCE (\$200,000)

Redesign the main entrance by pushing out the steps and adding a ramp to make the main entrance more handicap accessible. Redesign the plaza to be more visitor friendly and visually appealing and improve outdoor lighting



#### SHRINES & SANCTUARY (\$75.000)

Refresh the painting, treatment and condition of the sanctuary, shrines, statues and mosaic



#### ACCESSIBILITY (\$25,000)

Improve the south west door entrance for greater handicap accessibility



#### LIGHTING (\$75.000)

Convert to energy efficient LED lighting, re-direct overhead lights for the Stations of the Cross



#### FINISHING TOUCHES (TBD)

Redesign the bulletin board/bookrack in the south west entrance, apply fresh paint where needed, clean the interior masonry, and clean the exterior of the church building including the bell tower
