Rooted in Faith Grant

As part of the Rooted in Faith Campaign, Principal Sandie Isabella wrote and recieved a \$60,000 grant to replace the existing classroom doors in the school with new security doors. The current doors are the original doors which do not lock from the inside and have too much glass to be safe. In a lockdown situation, the new doors will provide a way to keep intruders out of the classrooms.

Know what the symbol to the left is?

It is a QR code (Quick Response Code). It was invented in 1994 for use in manufacturing to allow for high speed scanning. You now can see them on packages from the UPS, in the mall, and on TV. QR codes are used to share web or email addresses easily. You just snap a picture with your phone of the code in a QR App and it will take you to the website.

How did the St. Sebastian Sport Teams get Named the "Terriers"?

Up until 1948, the St. Sebastian athletic teams were known as the "Bulldogs." Football was a very big sport in the CYO league and St. Sebastian fielded an excellent team in 1948. The team was comprised of 7th and 8th grade boys. They won the CYO Championship! The top team member was Terry Coyle. The story goes on that they renamed the team, "The Terriers," as a result of Terry's skill in that 1948 championship season.
