MONDAY: Chili Con Carne, Bread & Butter Sandwich, Milk or Cocoa - 15 cents TUESDAY: Rice with sugar and milk, Bread & Butter Sandwich, Milk or Cocoa - 15 cents WEDNESDAY: Cream of Tomato Soup or Bean Soup, 2 Bread & Butter Sandwiches, Milk or Cocoa - 15 cents THURSDAY: Wiener Sandwiches - Milk or Cocoa - 15 cents FRIDAY: Creamed Peas & Eggs on Toast, Bread & Butter Sandwich, Milk or Cocoa - 15 cents.

Tickets: 70 cents Tickets may be left at the cafeteria if desired.


