CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

The extension of the construction from Mull down Greenwood that blocked one of our parking entrances at the church did not take place until after last week's bulletin was sent out and so I was unable to give you a heads up. All of the last-minute construction also had an interesting effect on our Eucharistic Procession route.

Currently, the crossing of Mull Avenue is a bit of a challenge as many of you discovered last week. The road will remain this way until the end of the month at which time concrete will be poured in preparation for the eventual laying of bricks. The Hale and Hardy may make this trek yet, but for the rest, please use Hawkins or Mineola (to swing around Schneider Park) and approach the parish from the south. There are fewer obstacles from that direction.

Please add a couple of minutes to your arrival time especially if you are accustomed to arriving right on time in order to give yourself enough time if you must park further away.
