ANGEL SCHOLARSHIP

Thank you to everyone who has chosen to support St. Sebastian Parish School through the Angel Scholarship Fund! This program allows Ohioans to receive a 100% Ohio tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) for cash donations to the Angel Scholarship Fund, and St. Sebastian may be selected to receive your donation. For the 2023-24 school year, the school has been able to distribute almost \$70,000 in Angel Fund monies to 86 students. We recently learned that 111 donors contributed over \$102,000 in 2023 to distribute for the 2024-25 school year (this is a preliminary total: final numbers will be released in mid-Feb. after any corrections are made and credit card fees are subtracted). We are pleased that this will enable us to help even more families next year! Please note this year there is an extended deadline for 2023 donations: Donations made by April 15, 2024, are eligible for the 2025-26 school year). In 1940, 39 students who belonged to St. Sebastian Parish attended Our Lady of the Elms School. Five of them were boys including the three Shea boys. Familiar names rounded out the roster including Amer, Werner and Seikel. Their addresses were all on familiar streets such as Exchange, Clemmer, Elmdale, Dorchester, Castle and Greenwood. There is no explication as to why this list exists and why only 1940 was held on to.
