LENTEN MISSION COMING UP QUICKLY!

Our Annual Parish Mission will be Sunday, February 25th through Tuesday the 27th with Fr. Thomas Blau O.P., a member of the Dominican Order [Order of Preachers]. He is an itinerant preacher in the Diocese of Columbus doing parish missions with his residence at St. Patrick Priory. He is one of the Pontifical Missionaries of Mercy of the Catholic Church, an inducted "Magistral Chaplain" for the Knights of Malta, and the local chaplain for the Columbus Legatus organization. He is also the founder of "St. Barnabas Ministry" which provides a Dominican priest ready to take over a diocesan parish to allow the priest to go on vacation or retreat. Fr. Blau is one of the Eucharistic Preachers selected by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for the Eucharistic Revival.



GOINGS ON AROUND ST. SEBASTIAN SQUARE

Last Wednesday, our new mayor, the Honorable Shammas Malik, was here at St. Sebastian Parish, in Zwisler Hall for a Ward 4 meeting. One of the things he said was, "Father, we are going to get Mull Ave. finished for you!" One of the more interesting things that I learned was the fate of the speed tables that were once on Garman Road. Apparently, they were temporary speed bumps that moved around the city when and where needed. (I just thought that too many people complained.) Eventually he would like to install them more permanently in certain places as test pilots, some of them will be installed soon.

Lots of work continues at Perkins (Good Park). Large machines are digging away there every day but as of this writing, there has not been any vertical construction as of yet. The new Fire Station, however, is coming along nicely. Be sure to look next time you pass.

FROM THE FORGOTTEN CABINET

As you should be aware, this spring we will be building and re-establishing a greenhouse on our campus. One of the files in the cabinet concerned the original greenhouse and toolshed. The complete bill for this building was sent on 20 November 1950 from Kraus and Helmkamp Architects who designed and built all of the St. Sebastian Parish buildings. For design, materials and construction, the bill for the building came to a whopping \$4,394.01! To put things in perspective, about twelve years ago, we were contemplating building a brick enclosure for our dumpsters and the cost for design through construction was going to be \$10,000! That was a dear price at the time and so we built a wooden enclosure.
