Of course, there were the paintings of "The Placing of Christ in the Tomb" by Ukrainian artist Litvinov Oleg Arkadievich, and the paintings of the Crucifixion and the Resurrection of Christ by Pennsylvanian artist Eric Armusik. Local artist Carly Politano once again hand painted our unique Paschal candle.

Terry Tolson created our Tomb scene, which she pulled together last year from scratch. The "Passion Clock" was made for our parish to make us mindful of the events in Our Lord's life from the Passover Meal to His Death. Karen Spangler and Carly Politano made our vestments, and all of this was accompanied by our custom pipe organ in a building designed by Akron native Robert Kraus.


The second picture is of the painting of the Resurrection by Eric Armusik and Easter decorations by our Art and Environment Ministry Chair Terry Tolson.

FROM THE FORGOTTEN CABINET

The 1950 School Board folder is profoundly uninteresting. This did allow me to notice the tag line under the Diocesan School News banner which wonderfully states, "True education . . . is . . . wholly directed towards man's last end." Pius XI

Other than that, around Christmas was printed some recipes for sweets and snacks that the writer hoped would be healthier for children. I wonder what a modern nutritionist would say. Here are the recipes:

POPCORN BALLS: Pop about four quarts of corn and then place in a saucepan:

3/4 cup brown sugar

3/4 cup white sugar

1/2 cup molasses

1/2 cup water

1 Tablespoon vinegar

2 Tablespoons of butter

Cook without stirring until the mixture forms a hard ball when dropped into cold water. Add 1/4 teaspoon soda. Pour the syrup over the popcorn and mix well. When cool enough to handle, form into ball.

DATE SHIPS: Stuff dates with peanut butter and insert halves of peanuts for sails.

HONEY MILK BALLS:

1 Tablespoon honey

4 Tablespoons peanut butter

1/2 cup dry skim milk

1/4 cup wheat flakes, crushed

Mix honey and peanut butter. Gradually add dry skim milk, mixing well. Form into balls with greased hands. Roll in wheat flakes. Chill until firm. Makes 18 balls.

GOLDEN SANDWICHES: Place half a marshmallow between halves of dried apricots.

PEANUT BUTTER RAISIN BALLS:

1 cup peanut butter

1/2 cup powdered sugar

1/2 cup dry skim milk

2 cups seeded raisins

1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Granulated sugar

Put the raisins through the food grinder. Mix the peanut butter, powdered sugar, and dry skim milk. Add the raisins and vanilla. Moisten with enough liquid so the mixture will hold its shape when formed into small balls. Roll the balls in granulated sugar. Using the chunky style peanut butter or adding chopped nuts makes a tasty variation.
