WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR THIS CHRISTMAS WEEKEND

Friday Mass at 8 a.m. with Fr. Bozek Friday Confessions at 4 p.m.

CHRISTMAS MASSES:

(Sunday) Vigil Mass at 4 p.m. with Fr. Valencheck Mass at 7 p.m. with Fr. Bozek MIDNIGHT Mass at 12 a.m. with Fr. Valencheck

(Monday) Christmas Mass at 9 a.m. with Fr. Bozek Christmas Mass at 11 a.m. with Fr. Valencheck

FROM THE FORGOTTEN CABINET

Those reading this are likely to be on a break from school and so the topic may not be so up lifting. It is years of contracts between Akron City Schools and St. Sebastian Parish School concerning bus transportation. Almost every year is the same, "Please sign the enclosed agreement and return." The "AGREEMENT, made and concluded at Krohn, Ohio, this 30th day August 1958, by and between THE AKRON TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, a corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Company", and ST. SEBASTIAN SCHOOL, Akron, Ohio;

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, St. Sebastian School maintains and operates a parochial school located at 500 Mull Avenue, Akron, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Company now operates a bus for said school, herein designates as "Bus A", to transport pupils to and from said school and

WHEREAS, Bus A now in operation is capable of handling the morning inbound passengers to said school, but is incapable of handling the afternoon outbound load; and

WHEREAS, the Company is willing to put into operation an additional bus designated herein as "Bus B", to assist the handling of the outbound afternoon passengers,

In consideration of the promises and agreements of said St. Sebastian School herein set forth, it is mutual agreed by and between the parties hereto upon the consideration aforesaid as follows:

- 1. The Company will operate Bus B, leaving the school at approximately 3:45 P.M.
- 2. The Company will operate Bus B along a specified route to be agreed upon in advance between the Company and the School. . . .
- 3. It is mutually understood that in the event the streets over which said bus traverse to cover its route become impassable, the Company may, if necessary, discontinue and suspend such service during such said time . . .
- 4. St. Sebastian School will guarantee to the Company the sum of Nine Dollars (\$9) (plus federal income tax, if

applicable) for the services afforded by Bus B, which sum is recognized by both parties as the operating cost to the Company for such service. It is understood, however, that the children riding Bus B will pay the school rate of fare based on ten (10) tickets for One Dollar and Twenty Cents (\$1.20), the difference billed to St. Sebastian School.
