 - 332 total enrollment
 - Processed 198 Ed Choice applications, with 42 traditional Ed Choice, and 156 expansion
 - Statuses of applications can be received, under review or awarded review parent dashboard
 - School is notified if an app needs reviewed
 - A tutorial will be create to navigate the Ed Choice website, parent dashboard
 - Once there is a credit balance in your student account, a check will be issued
 - The option to leave the money in the student account for the next school year is an option
 - Checks are issued to the parent; parent will sign a Power of Attorney that will allow the school to handle the monies; Diana will send out P.O.A once a check has been received by the school
 - Funding will be applied to students in the following order:
 - Ed Choice
 - Parish Life Scholarship
 - All other monies
 - If monies are not needed, the overage goes back to the person/organization providing funding and re-allocated
 - No multi-child discount for the 23-24 school year
 - Moving to scholarship based model instead of discount model
 - Have to gauge active parishioners and what that means now
 - Option to have parent volunteers to handle small task for Diana as she processes Ed Choice applications
 - Milissa will follow up at the state and Diocese to updated parents
