Dear Father Swisler (sic)

The enclosed check for \$100 is for enrollment of Richard Karam in school for the coming school year. I'm sure you will find him an apt pupil and if there is anything further needed, please let me know.

The second note is from March 16th, 1954:

Dear Fr. Zwisler,

Just a note to say thank you for letting Charles attend school these past two years, since we were not members of your parish. We are moving April 14th to Rocky River and will be members of St. Christopher Parish. I understand they have the same order of Sisters teaching in their school so I imagine the change for him will be very small.
