Linda	 Rectory Volunteers - Jennifer retired last Monday, so I'm putting together a list of volunteers who may volunteer weekly in the office to help me out. I may put an article in the bulletin to get a few more volunteers! Pre-Cana - nothing new right now.
Dave	 CYO Athletics - Fall sports starts August 27th. Schedules are available. There are 37 kids in Cross Country; new this year is a 1st/2nd grade team (6 kids so far). Football has 36 kids: a 6 th grade team and a % grade team. Flag football has 26 kids making up two teams. Soccer has 56 kids (4 teams) - ¾ boys and girls, % girls and % girls. DD Stars has 130 kids (5 teams). Volleyball has 3 teams (4th, 5th and 7th). Cheerleading had 6 kids interested but no team was formed. Maybe have a squad next year. Athletic Booster Club - registrations are cash only (no credit cards, no Venmo/PayPal). After registration closes, CYO wants fees paid in 24 hours. Very difficult to do with a cash only situation. There will be a concession stand inside the main doors at Byrider. Financial support - some families have requested a payment plan (Boosters can ok it). Other requests for reduced or waived fees due to hardship. CYO would cover this if parish couldn't. Mission Expansion - kids within parish boundaries that aren't going to St Sebastian can still play CYO sports. Parish must opt in for each season. For this Fall, there are 4 such families with 5 kids total.
Sue	No updates as there were no replies to inquiries.
Ed	 SVDP-Buried! with over 20 requests for assistance per week. High volume is causing a backlog of requests. Spent \$24,000. in the last 4 weeks. Soon will not be able to take any more 2-1-1 calls even within our boundaries. Will keep taking calls until our treasury gets to the point that we have to slow down on taking requests. Causes? Increases in rent, food, gas, and all 3 utilities and the fact that utility companies prefer to shut off delinquent accounts during the summer months so as not to be accused of freezing people to death in the winter. Able to do all this due to a very generous 5-figure anonymous gift given last month. SOCIAL JUSTICE-After their summer recess the committee has taken up studying Pope Francus's recent Apostolic Constitution, Predicate Evangelium, ON THE ROMAN CURIA AND ITS SERVICE TO THE CHURCH IN THE WORLD.

Finance Council

- The last Finance Council meeting was August 4
- Finance Council is getting bids on the back driveway of the school and rectory; working on selecting between three vendors
- Fr. Valencheck talked about the 100th Anniversary and campaign to add a gym on the church/school side of Hawkins
- St. Sebastian is in the top 7% of parishes in the diocese taking advantage of the Angel Scholarship! (\$750 individual/\$1,500 joint)
- Seminarians are going back to school
- As of August 4, Mr. Rohr reported there were 327 students registered for the day school and 49 in the preschool with a few spots remaining in the 3-year-old class
- There are two new teachers for preschool and first grade; looking for aids (there's an ad in the bulletin looking for helpers)
- All the HAVEN Lockdown Locks were installed (https://havenlockdown.com/ if you want to read more!); also camera and server upgrades and new swipe cards across the campus
- Financials (which are broken down by church and the school):
 - Church: Revenue was up \$75K YOY but expenses were \$75K more so 2021 was a break even year
 - School revenue \$1.8M revenue from tuition; \$90K more in expenses and \$40K less revenue
 - Net net we had a net loss of \$89,000
- Church roof work is being done in October
- A lot of work is being done to Byrider Hall
- September 22 is the next Finance Council meeting
